Treasurer's report - John Matkovich

Comments:

Expenses are tracking as per the budget.

In 2017, there were no dues collected, the Zinfandel Session was expenditure, and there were no revenues from the 2017 Nationals. As a result, there was a deficit.

Provincial Competition 2018 Chief Stewart's - Mike Leeper, Vinovan

There were 220 entries received into the competition. The medal distribution was: Gold – 18; Silver – 50; Bronze 89 for a total of 159 medals or 71% of the entries. Club Entries were as follows:

National Director's report (AWC) - Doug Markin.

- Ivan Herbert the Secretary/Treasurer passed away..
- The 2018 Amateur Winemakers of Canada Competition will be held Saturday and Sunday August 25th & 26th 2018 in Kentville, Nova Scotia. Entry instructions and regulations will be issued at a later date. Doug & Cathy Markin along with Rick and Mary Homer will be judging.

Guild Master's Report - Mary Homer (absent) - notes read by Mike Leeper.

Comments:

The Report tabled at the March BCAWA meeting are still relevant.

Axel Kroitzsch a BC Guild of Wine Judges Educator , commented:

- Training on the Lower Mainland and Vancouver Island was held and a comprehensive manual has been developed. The feedback on the course was very positive. A course is 4 weekends long and the cost to put on a course is \$300. 10 students are required. Students will learn a lot about wines and will learn a good methodology to evaluate wine.
- 4 people judged at the 2018 Provincials.
- The Personal Consistency of Judges has improved at the monthly Guild Tastings.
- There continues to be a need to train new judges to ensure there are sufficient judges for BCAWA competitions.

Old Business

Review BCAWA Classes in comparison to AWC Classes. - John Matkovich

John Matkovich (not John McMaster as previously stated) will work with Axel and Clem to review the classes by Mid-Fall prior to the Vinovan competition.

- A training session for Syrah can be delivered similar to the one prepared for Zinfandel providing there is a volunteer to organize it. The 2017 Zin session did have a component on what to do with red wine grapes like Syrah.

Transportation Logistics of Wine to Competitions – Larry McIntyre

Comments:

Clubs are encouraged to connect with other clubs to see if there are ways to take advantage of people travelling on the ferry as a way to reduce costs of transporting wine to competitions.

Visit to Kamloops by BCAWA and Guild
