Competition Rules

Entrants must be members in good standing of Nanaimo Winemakers.

All wines entered must be made by the member at home. No wines made in a U-Brew are allowed.

All entrants should use the Official Classes, Entry Regulations and Presentation of Entry rules as posted on the BCAWA site: <http://www.bcawa.ca>.

Nanaimo Winemakers 2022 Wine Competition On-line Entry Procedure

1. Login onto BCAWA website <http://www.bcawa.ca>.
2. Once on the website, find the tabs on the left-hand side of the screen.
3. Click on "Provincial Competition", then "Wine Competition System".
4. Sign up or log onto the system.
5. Select "2022 Nanaimo Winemakers" and enter your information.
6. When you have entered all your wines, print 2 copies of the entry form as well as a copy of the bottle tags. Attach the bottle tags to each bottle with an elastic band. Keep one copy of the entry form for your records. Put the second copy of your entry form plus your payment with your wine entries.

When filling in the on-line registration form, please include vintage and complete the information on the source of the grapes or juice. Varietal wines must include the percentage of the named variety. Blends must include percentages of principal components and if possible, the pH, TA, per cent alcohol, residual sugar should be stated.

Classes used for our NW Competition and their codes correspond with the official BCAWA class descriptions found on the BCAWA website.

Please read the BCAWA descriptions carefully to ensure that you enter your wines correctly in their appropriate classes.

- C1 – Chardonnay
- C2 – Aromatic White Vinifera
- C4 – Other Dry White
- C5 – Dry White Pinot
- D - Rose
- E1 – Dry Red Bordeaux Style
- E2 – Dry Red Pinot

E3 – Non-Vinifera Red Grape
E4 – Dry Red Zinfandel
E5 – Rhone Style Dry Red
E6 – Other Dry Red
E7 – Dry Red Cabernet Sauvignon
F – Dessert
G – After Dinner
H – Sparkling and Cider
I - Social Wine
J1 - Country Table
J2 - Country Social

Regulations for Entries

- * Maximum of 3 entries per class. Each wine in the same class must be from different varieties, years or vineyards.
- * Wines made with kits can be entered in their respective grape classes.
- * Different yeast, oak chips or slight adjustments to ingredients do not make “different” wines.
- * Entry fee is \$4 per bottle. Include your entry form and fee with your bottle entries and bottle tags. Pay entry by cheque made out to Nanaimo Winemakers or pay in cash.
- * All table wine entries must be presented in bottles of 750ml capacity. All other classes may be entered in 375ml bottles.
- * There must be no labels, shrink caps, or other distinguishing marks on bottles.
- * Closing date for all entries is **May 16**.
- * Entries must be dropped off no later than **May 20**.
